Kenan, Owen Hill

publisher." [2]Owen Hill Kenan, physician, was born in Kenansville, the oldest child of James Graham and Anne Elizabeth Hill Kenan. After graduation from <u>The University of North Carolina</u> [3] in 1894, he received a medical degree from the <u>University of Pennsylvania</u> [4]. He practiced medicine first in Kenansville and later in New York City and Palm Beach, Fla.

A world traveler, Kenan was one of the few survivors of the Lusitania [5] disaster when the vessel was torpedoed by a German submarine off the Irish coast in 1915. He joined the French Army and was awarded the French Medal of Honor. When the United States entered World War I [6], he joined an American unit and attained the rank of colonel. In later years he lived and maintained homes in Paris, France; Palm Beach, Fla.; and Wilmington [7], N.C. He was an art collector and an authority on eighteenth-century French art.

Kenan was a member of St. James Episcopal Church, Wilmington, and of Bethesda By the Sea Episcopal Church, Palm Beach; he was buried in <u>Arlington National Cemetery</u> [8]. He never married.
