Like most Southeast Asians, Indonesians eat the same kinds of food in the morning as they do at night. Large bowls of rice with smaller side dishes of vegetables, meat, or fish are considered desirable meals any time of day. Many people eat full meals only two times a day although smaller snacks and drinks will be consumed in between. Portions of meat or fish consumed in Southeast Asia also are much smaller than those eaten in the United States.
