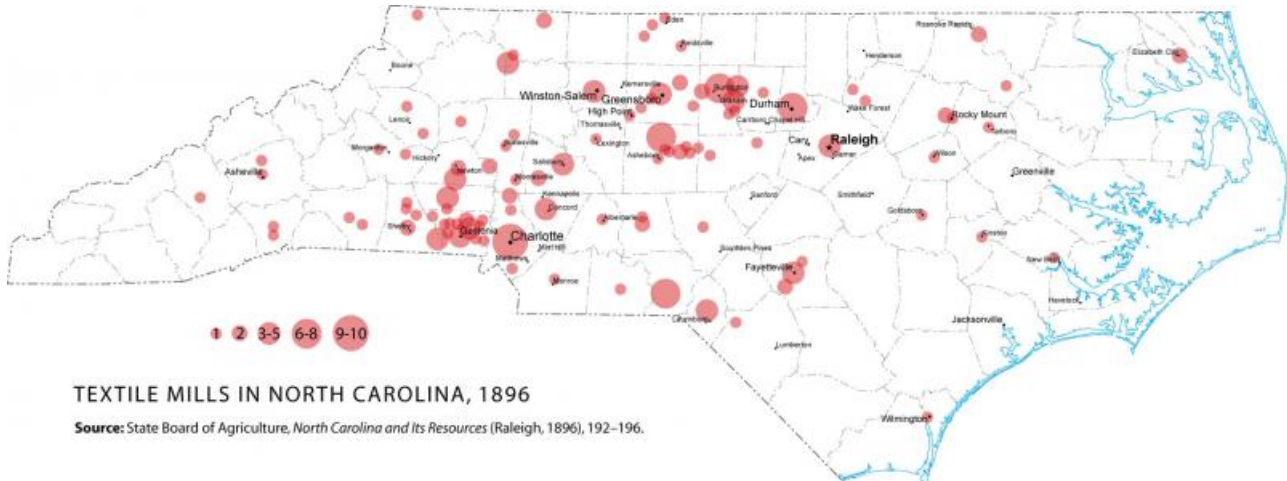


Textile mills in North Carolina, 1896
