Widely considered Mexico's leading novelist, and formerly the ambassador to France, Carlos Fuentes (b. 1928) divides his time between Mexico City and London. A prolific and acclaimed author, winner of the prestigious Cervantes Prize, his works include *The Death of Artemio Cruz*, *The Old Gringo*, *A New Time for Mexico*, and *The Crystal Frontier*.
