grape (*Vitis labrusca*) thrives in North Carolina's <u>piedmont</u> <sup>[6]</sup> and <u>mountain</u> <sup>[6]</sup> regions. One variety of fox grape, the Catawba, was apparently first found along the banks of Cane Creek south of Swannanoa in <u>Buncombe County</u> <sup>[7]</sup>. Catawba wine also became a popular antebellum spirit well outside the South, fortifying <u>Harriet Beecher Stowe</u> <sup>[8]</sup> in her

## literary campaign against slavery.
