### ***Suedliche Post***

The *Suedliche Post* (Southern Post) was a short-lived German-language newspaper founded in [Goldsboro](#) <sup>[2]</sup> in 1869 by [August Heinrich Christian Julius Bonitz](#) <sup>[3]</sup> (who usually signed his name Julius A. Bonitz). The newspaper sought to benefit the substantial number of German-speaking residents in the area. Bonitz, a native of [Clausthal-Zellerfeld, Germany](#) <sup>[4]</sup>, had settled in Goldsboro, where he published the successful English-language papers *Daily Rough Notes* <sup>[5]</sup> and the *Messenger* <sup>[6]</sup>, both stoutly "advocating the supremacy of the white race." In addition, he was agent for the [Carolina Immigration Association](#) <sup>[7]</sup>, which encouraged foreigners to buy land in North Carolina; the *Die Suedliche Post* was its "adopted organ." Only three issues of the paper are known to be preserved; the last (number 9) was dated 27 Nov. 1869.
