^[2]Kenneth Raynor Ellington, partner in architectural firm, was born in Clayton, the son of Jesse and Sallie Williamson Ellington. In 1914 he received the LL.B. degree from [The University of North Carolina](#) ^[3] where he was a member of Gorgon's Head, an honorary society. After serving in the Navy Air Corps during [World War I](#) ^[4], he joined the architectural office of his brother Douglas in Asheville and participated in the work of the firm (See [Ellington, Douglas D.](#) ^[5].) A [Baptist](#) ^[6], he married Margaret Roberts in 1922 and they were the parents of a son, Eric Edward.
