### **Kenan, Owen Hill**

<sup>[2]</sup>Owen Hill Kenan, physician, was born in Kenansville, the oldest child of James Graham and Anne Elizabeth Hill Kenan. After graduation from [The University of North Carolina](#) <sup>[3]</sup> in 1894, he received a medical degree from the [University of Pennsylvania](#) <sup>[4]</sup>. He practiced medicine first in Kenansville and later in New York City and Palm Beach, Fla.

A world traveler, Kenan was one of the few survivors of the [Lusitania](#) <sup>[5]</sup> disaster when the vessel was torpedoed by a German submarine off the Irish coast in 1915. He joined the French Army and was awarded the French Medal of Honor. When the United States entered [World War I](#) <sup>[6]</sup>, he joined an American unit and attained the rank of colonel. In later years he lived and maintained homes in Paris, France; Palm Beach, Fla.; and [Wilmington](#) <sup>[7]</sup>, N.C. He was an art collector and an authority on eighteenth-century French art.

Kenan was a member of St. James Episcopal Church, Wilmington, and of Bethesda By the Sea Episcopal Church, Palm Beach; he was buried in [Arlington National Cemetery](#) <sup>[8]</sup>. He never married.
